Legal

During our guided rides, no drugs, liquor or firearms are permitted. If you are camping, we only rent the equipment, so what you do while on your own camping time is up to you. Please be courteous and obey applicable laws as well as respect our environment. No pets are permitted during ATV tours. Our drivers must be a least 16 years old and have a valid class 5 drivers' licence. Passengers must be at least 8 years old. All participants under the age of 18 must have a legal guardian sign to approve the participation of the minor



Participants must sign a general waiver that releases Outsy.ca from all liability

Booking and Refund

25% deposit is due at time of booking. The balance is due 14 calendar days from date for tour(s).

We welcome riders with their own ATV, we offer a reduced rate for anyone who brings their own machine.

Cancellations will receive a 95% refund for requests over 30 days from a booked trip or package. 5% is kept for administrative costs. Cancellations within 30 days of the booked tour or package are not subject to refunds.

Rentals and Corporate Clients

Our units are available for rentals subject to availability and the discretion of Outsy.ca. All rental rates available on request. A damage deposit of 1000.00 per unit must be pre-authorized on a major credit card. A general liability and rental agreement are required. Discounts for bulk business available. This privacy policy has been compiled to better serve those who are concerned with how their 'Personally identifiable information' (PII) is being used online. We do not use an SSL certificate because our card possessing partner keeps transaction information for online transactions secure in their system. Online, we do not access this sensitive data, only contact information. For email and phone bookings, we process transactions and immediately destroy credit card information after the transaction.

Do we use 'cookies'?

We do not use cookies for tracking purposes

You can choose to have your computer warn you each time a cookie is being sent, or you can choose to turn off all cookies. You do this through your browser (like Internet Explorer) settings.
